Priests on hand to hear Confessions, December 17, 19 and 20

We've all heard the saying that "Confession is good for the soul." Confession helps us to face ourselves and the way we have been living, and to unburden ourselves. But the greatest value in sacramental confession is in receiving the forgiveness of Christ. As hard as it may be to believe, God looks at us with eyes of mercy and forgiveness, and sees possibilities where we only see failure and a cycle of repetition.

Advent is a great time to avail ourselves of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. *On Saturday, December 17, confessions will be heard from 9:00 – 10:00 a.m. and again from 3:30 – 4:45 p.m.* A number of priests will be available.

Confessions will also be heard on Monday, December 19 and Tuesday, December 20 from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. in church.

Individuals for whom these times don't work can call the Rectory and arrange for a special time for confession.
