Dear Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parents, Faculty, Students, and Staff:

Beginning on Friday, January 13 and ending on Wednesday, January 25, we will be processing orders for February and March.

A couple helpful hints before you get started:

- 1.) The meal packages are grouped by day and cannot be separated by specific meal. By selecting "Monday" your child will receive lunch every Monday; by selecting "Tuesday" your child will receive lunch every Tuesday, etc. We apologize, but we cannot pro-rate or divide the meal packages if your child only wants 3 out of 4 Monday meals.
- 2.) We do not offer refunds for missed lunches due to sick days, doctor's appointments, etc.
- 3.) We offer a vegetarian counterpart for every single meal. If your child would like the vegetarian meal, please include that information in the Additional Notes box on the payment page.
- 4.) The items on the menu rotate and will do so for the entirety of the ordering cycle, which lasts for two months.
- 5.) Although you are ordering lunch for two months, your credit card will be charged two pro-rated amounts (at the start of lunch service in February, and then at the beginning of March).
- 6.) **OrganicLife will offer a full refund on uneaten meals if orders are cancelled within the first 10 days of lunch service. After February 10 no changes will be accepted to your order.**

To Order Your Lunch!

- 1.) Go to <http://order.organiclifeonline.com/olph>
- 2.) Click the box on the days you'd like hot lunch.
- 3.) Select your child's grade. Enter your child's first /last name and homeroom teacher.
- 4.) Click "Add to Cart."
- 5.) On the next page, you can review your order. If you have another child at the school, click "add another child." This will take you back to the first page where you select the days for that child, enter his/her information, and again, "add to cart."
- 6.) Once your order is complete, create your account with email address, billing info, etc. Click "Submit" once, and you're done!

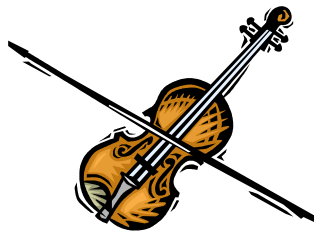

Capital Campaign Update

We have reached our initial goal, and with your help we can accomplish even more!

As 2012 begins, we give thanks for the generous spirit of our parishioners. From our parish community of 3,217 households, 720 families have committed their financial resources to our capital campaign.

The campaign supports two large projects that will enhance our campus' beauty, safety and accessibility. The capital campaign's preliminary goal has been reached and improvements will begin in June.

We are joyful, but not yet satisfied. Parish leadership set a preliminary fund raising goal that was conservative and practical in a time of economic uncertainty. In addition, *we are not yet at our goal of 1,000 families participating.*

We have an opportunity to surpass our participation goal *and tackle a third project: much needed improvements in our Playdium.* The gym floor and bleachers need to be replaced.

As you probably know, the Playdium is a primary gathering place for many ministries and parish organizations. To name just a few: Big Night, The Holly Fair, St. Patrick's Day Party, The Sharing Picnic, School Grandparent's Day, Scouts' Pancake Breakfast, OLPH Zone, Youth Basketball programs, Men's Basketball and Roundball.

With your help we can continue to provide the facilities for many wonderful events and enhance our recreation programs for the next generation of OLPH parishioners.

We are so grateful for the past and hope you can find a way to join the campaign and give to the future.
